Then at the Tandy Company for a while before landing her final job at the Social Security Administration Office where she filed claims.

Charlotte worked for the Social Security Administration where she retired after 20 years.

Charlotte loved bowling and has bowled for over 20 years; was a league secretary for 8 years, and trust me that's not a job for the faint of heart. Nobody wants it. It's like herding snails or sometimes babysitting kids. They know what's legal in the rules, most have been bowling for years. She traveled for numerous Women's National Bowling tournaments, to Reno, Las Vegas, Detroit, Charlotte, El Paso, San Antonio, Houston, New Braunfels, Syracuse, Baton Rouge, New Orleans as well as local women's tournaments here in the DFW area.

She loved traveling and has been on 4 cruises, 3 of them to Alaska. Drove to the tournaments the last 13 or so years just so she could see the sights along the way. She enjoyed life.

Charlotte had no children of her own but has a step-son, a daughter-in-law and 8 grandchildren she calls her own as well as they also call her grandma. Once you met Charlotte you couldn't help but love her. She had the most loving, caring heart of anyone you could ever hope to meet.

She loved Christmas more than bowling, and if you've never been to her house at Christmas you're missing out. It's literally a walk-through tour. Every room gets decorated. It really is amazingly beautiful.

I want to thank Pamela Conway, Sierra Baker and Lesa Avery, the aides that helped me with Charlotte getting bathed, dressed etc. You made her feel normal, dignified and I know that helped her feel like a normal person. I can't tell you how much that meant to her. My heartfelt thanks for your help. Words are not enough. You became like family to us. Thank you.

I want to leave you with a true and fascinating story of how god's timing is so perfect: Mom got a Facebook post a few days ago and there was a picture of a cross with a note on it that said "Gone to Dad's to prepare a place for you, be back to pick you up soon! Jesus."

She thought that was an awesome photo so she reposted it, and the next day, Charlotte passed. A friend posted a Facebook post and sent it to mom saying that picture was perfect for Charlotte's passing. You call it what you want, but I'm calling it God's plan, and his timing is always perfect, if you just believe as I do.
