She loved learning new things and was an avid reader, mostly reading murder mysteries. Each year she set a goal to read at least 100 books by the end of the year and every year she surpassed that goal by at least 20-30 books. She was skeptical of the Kindle technology at first, however once she realized she could buy any book she wanted in an instant she was sold.

Pat had a love for sports that was unmatched by many. Everyone knew that you did not call the house to chat while "the game" was on. She grew up watching Notre Dame Football and would always remember back to taking the train to watch games with her father growing up. Her love for the Dallas Cowboys was so profound she named her youngest daughter after the team and Thanksgiving meals were coordinated around when the Cowboys played. She and Alan attended many spring training games to watch the Texas Rangers and it was a rare occurrence for her to miss a game on TV, even watching the replay the next day if the game was on past her bedtime of 7:30pm.
