Tommye Jane Holt, 89, passed away Dec. 22, 2020, at Baylor Scott & White All Saints Medical Center in Fort Worth, Texas.

Tommye was born March 20, 1931, in Oglesby, Texas to the late William Easter and Zora Mae Hudson Lamb. Tommye lived a long, beautiful life with her sweetheart and husband of 65 years, Bradford Holt, who passed away in Oct. of 2017. She was a life-long resident of Texas. After Brad retired, they moved to Horseshoe Bay, Texas to be closer to their family, and she became an active member of the First Baptist Church in Marble Falls. Being married to a sports fanatic, Tommye became one herself. They enjoyed attending high school and college sporting events regularly, mainly basketball. They were faithful season ticket holders for the Baylor women's basketball team for several years. Tommye was a kind, generous, soft-hearted and beautiful woman who touched many hearts with her smile and giving personality.

Tommye was preceded in death by her oldest son, Steve.
